

# Can the Subnautica locker be decomposed



## Overview

They have 5×6 (30) item slots, and attempting to deconstruct a Wall Locker that contains items is not possible, resulting in a notification that the container is not empty. Click on the "LOCKER" text. Enter the desired text (ten character limit). Is it possible to deconstruct/destroy the Waterproof Locker in order to get its raw material back?

Destroying waterproof lockers is possible, but it will cost you extra resources instead of reclaiming any spent on them. If you didn't build it with the Habitat Builder, you can't deconstruct it. So now you ...

### Is it possible to deconstruct the Waterproof Lockers? : r/subnautica

You can't deconstruct them. If you don't want to keep them you can build a trashcan in your base and drop them there - they'll disappear after awhile.

### Can my waterproof locker be destroyed by anything? :: Subnautica

They seem to disappear after a while due to glitches and most of the time they vanish when an update comes out.



### What to do with Waterproof Lockers? : r/subnautica

You can only get rid of them, not reclaim anything from them. To get rid of them on Experimental: Put them into a trash can (not a biological trash can, just

regular).

### **Too many Waterproof Lockers ! :: Subnautica General Gameplay ...**

You can dispose of the lockers via the Trashcan, but there is no way to recover the Titanium used to make them.

### **Locker (Subnautica) , Subnautica Wiki , Fandom**

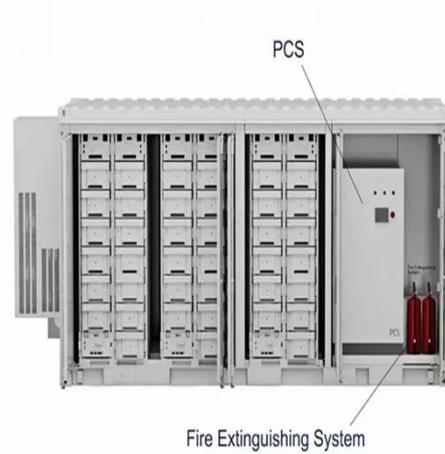
The Locker is freestanding, while the Wall Locker must be attached to a surface like a wall, and in a few cases, certain positions on interior pieces like the Nuclear Reactor or Vehicle Upgrade Console.

### **Waterproof Locker (Subnautica) , Subnautica Wiki , Fandom**

The Waterproof Locker can only be placed in the water and cannot be placed in a Seabase. When dropped, it

floats in the water similarly to the Beacon and can store up to sixteen items in a 4x4 space.
