

# Construction of large-scale energy storage projects in the Philippines



## Overview

---

A large-scale solar and battery energy storage project in the Philippines is moving forward faster than expected, with 54% of the first phase completed just eight months after construction began. Aboitiz Power disclosed that its joint venture, SN Aboitiz Power (SNAP) — formed with Norway-based renewable energy company Scatec — has reached "financial close" for two new BESS projects with a combined capacity of 80 megawatts (MW). By the end of June, 778 MW of solar capacity had already been installed—surpassing the initial 750 MW. The power generation arm of the Philippines' largest private electric distribution provider, Manila Electric Company (Meralco), is developing its second large-scale battery storage project. This series of closely linked strategic initiatives marks a. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Global Energy Alliance for People and Planet (GEAPP) have joined forces to launch ENABLE (Enhancing Access to Battery Energy Storage System for Low-carbon Economies). This innovative platform is designed to rapidly accelerate the adoption of battery energy.



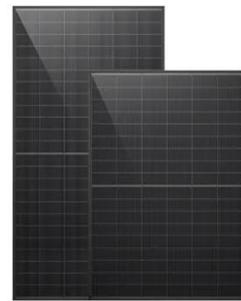
