

Georgia user-side energy storage device



Overview

BESS projects improve the efficiency of renewable energy by storing excess power during low-demand periods for use during high-demand times, such as cold winter mornings when solar energy is unavailable. These facilities address power needs identified in the 2023 IRP Update. Battery energy storage systems (BESS) are designed to address these challenges by storing excess renewable energy when demand is low and releasing it when demand is high. The Center of Innovation works as an advisor to companies making advancements in storage, which is impacting energy distribution and transmission systems (the smart grid), the reliability and availability of energy resources to. Georgia Power has requested certification from the Georgia Public Service Commission (PSC) for 9,900MW of new generation resources, including more than 3GW of battery storage that the utility would own. Approximately 8,000MW of the requested resources were chosen from an “all-source” request for. There are a few different state-level policies and regulations that can incentivize the deployment of energy storage technologies.
