The ITC — also known as the Federal Solar Tax Credit — is a popular tax rebate program offered by the US Federal Government for homeowners looking to switch to clean, renewable solar power. In August of 2022, the United States Congress extended the ITC while at the same time raising the total. If you invest in renewable energy for your home such as solar, wind, geothermal, fuel cells or battery storage technology, you may qualify for an annual residential clean energy tax credit. The Residential Clean Energy Credit equals 30% of the costs of new, qualified clean energy property for your. The Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates (HEAR), which we'll also refer to as the “electrification rebates,” make it more affordable for more Americans to install electric appliances and complete electrification upgrades for their homes.
