Most of the newer receptacles (post 1989) are designed to accept both the European (C) and Israel (H) style plugs, but not all hotels have newer receptacles. Look at this picture below.

Israel

Israel uses what is called a "H" type plug. This plug, which is unique to Israel, has two flat prongs that form a V-shape and a flat vertical grounding prong at the bottom.



Plug For Israel: What You Need To Know

North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Israel. North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Israel.

Israel Electric Plug Type: Will You Need An Adapter For Israel?

The standard voltage in Israel is 230V, and the frequency is 50Hz. Devices from countries with different voltage standards, like the United States (120V), may require a voltage converter in addition to a plug adapter.



Electrical Questions - Israel 2026

Some devices have a voltage switch that allows for use with different electrical standards. My most recent hotel rooms in Israel have all had one outlet in the

Clarification on electricity in Israel

Israel power runs at 220 volts 50 hertz. Plugs in Israel are unique to Israel, officially known as Type H plugs. Many plugs will also accept 2 prong Type C plugs (Continental Europe). British plugs will not fit. You should ...
