Amazon Hub Locker: 3 calendar days. FedEx Delivery Manager: 5 business days. USPS Parcel Lockers: Typically 10 days for PO boxes. InPost UK: 48 hours (extendable via app). How long will a package be left in a parcel locker?

Suppliers usually decide how long the shipment can stay before it is returned to them if it is not picked up. The period varies between 7 - 10 days (whether working or not).

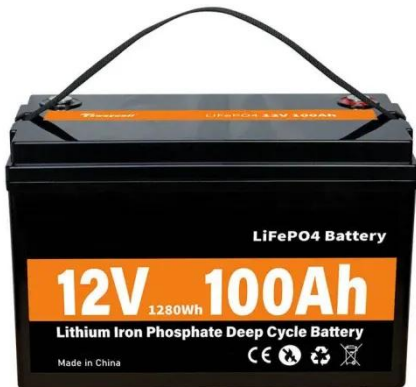
