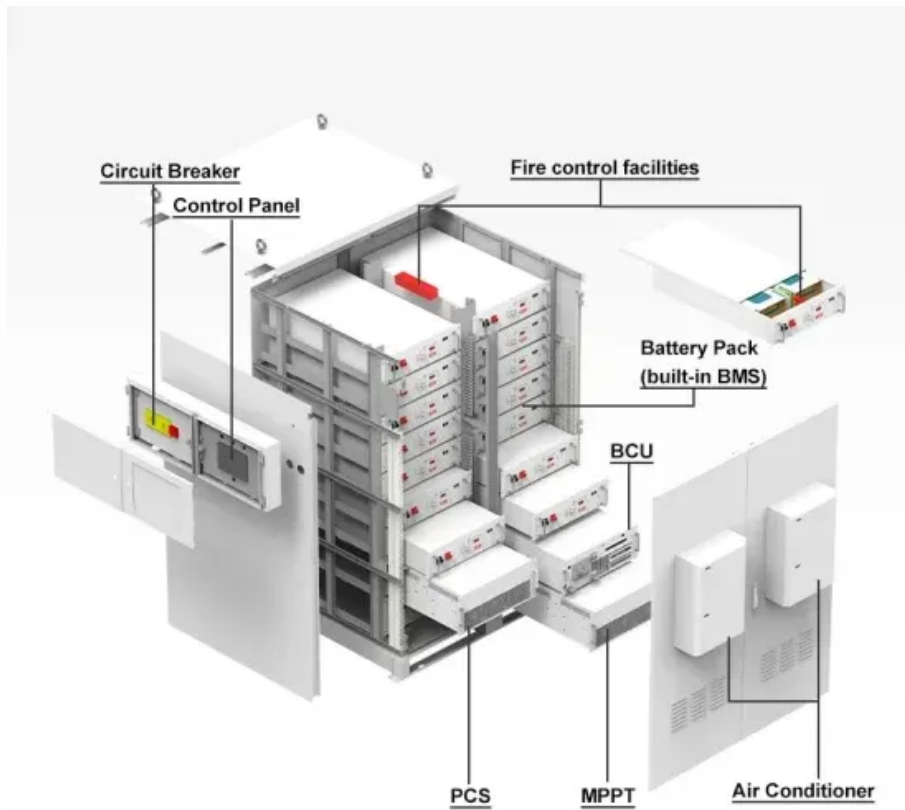


Lithium battery energy storage power station caught fire



Overview

When fire broke out at the world's largest battery energy storage facility in January 2025, its thick smoke blanketed surrounding wetlands, farms and nearby communities on the central California coast. A battery energy storage facility that was built inside an old power plant burned from Jan. Monterey County officials responded by declaring a state of emergency and ordering the evacuation of approximately. A few weeks ago, a fire broke out at the Moss Landing Power Plant in California, the world's largest collection of batteries on the grid. As Monterey's KSBW reports, the Moss Landing plant — which is owned by a Texas company called Vistra Energy and billed as the largest. A report released Friday by a clean-energy trade group spells out best practices for safe use of large-scale battery energy storage systems following a major fire at a battery facility early this year.

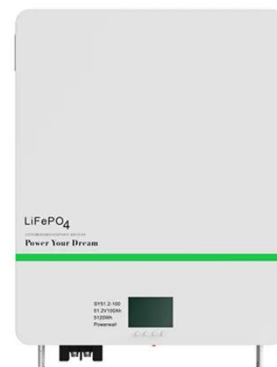
