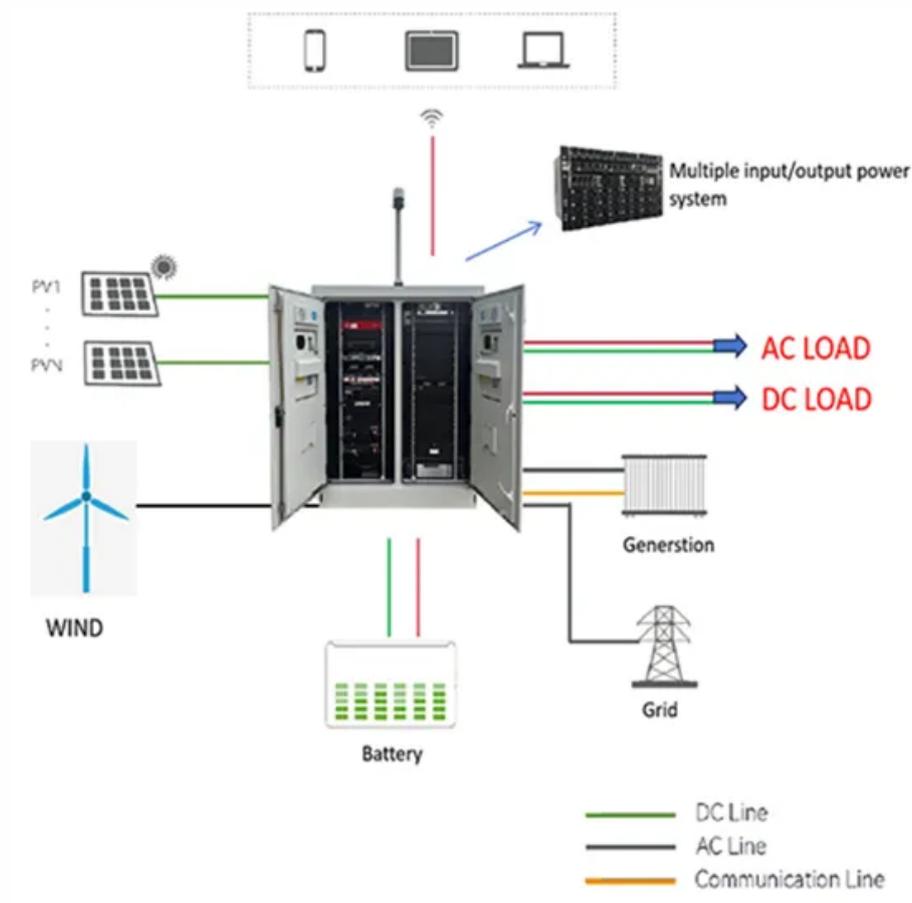


# Lithuania electric vehicle incentives



## Overview

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Purchase incentives (bonus) for individuals in 2025: €5,000 for a new BEV (<6 months), €2,500 for a used BEV (<4 years). Additional €1,000 for scrapping an old petrol/diesel vehicle. Subsidies available until 31 Dec 2026 or until funds are depleted. BEVs are exempt from. To encourage this trend, the government offers financial incentives to both individuals and businesses. In 2025, EV purchase subsidies become even more relevant, making it important to understand the applicable conditions, subsidy amounts, and the current market situation. A fully charged electric vehicle can travel up to 550 kilometres. Once the battery is low, it takes about 6 hours to recharge it at a public station. Under the Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Regulation (AFIR) Member States are required to ensure a minimum total power. Lithuania continues to provide incentives for the purchase of electric vehicles - the country's residents and companies can already apply for compensation for the purchase of pure electric vehicles from the funds allocated from the Modernisation Fund. The Ministry of Transport and Communications is allocating an additional 1,2 million euros.

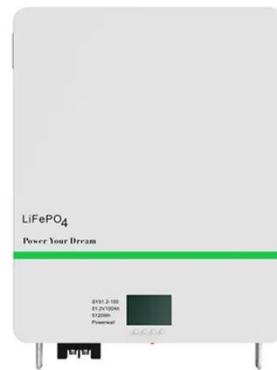
In June 2022, EUR50 million from the Modernization fund was allocated for the
