

Photovoltaic panel wiring color standard specification



Overview

Solar panel wiring follows standard color codes for safety: DC positive (red), DC negative (black), and grounding (green or bare copper). PV wires (UL 4703) must handle 600V–1500V and 90°C–105°C temperatures. USE-2 or PV wire (AWG 10–12) is common, with UV-resistant insulation. For AC connections. The intent of this bulletin is to clarify some of the wiring method requirements as per Section 64 Rules. Optional tin-coated copper conductors are also available upon request. All black insulation has a “Sunlight Resistant” rating.

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64-4-* Wiring methods for solar photovoltaic systems

Where a combiner box is not located within 1 m of PV modules or where conductors are run inside the building or structure, wiring methods specified in Section 12 are required.

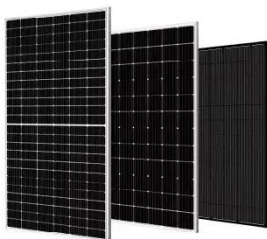
