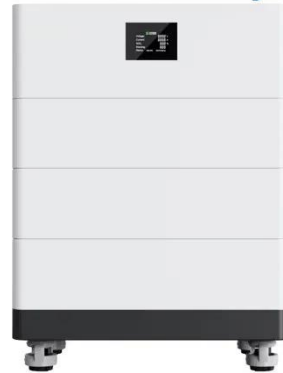
Gabon , Climate Promise

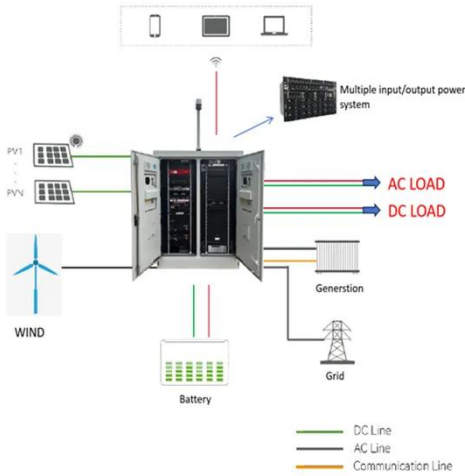
