Zambia inaugurated a 20 MW solar photovoltaic plant in Lusaka to diversify its power mix amid climate-driven hydropower constraints. Kiyona Energy, a ZESCO subsidiary, developed the project and will allocate 2 MW directly to the Natural Resources Development College. Under the agreement, a 100-megawatt (MW) pilot solar power plant is set to commence in April 2026. Zambia government plans to operationalize the project in April 2026 in the Itezhi-Tezhi District, with plans to complete each solar plant between 8 & 10 months.
