## Overview

---

With ABO, you are responsible for set fees each month, but you pay all your net energy charges just once a year, at the end of your 12-month cycle. If you prefer to pay your net energy charges monthly instead of annually, you can opt-in to MBO by logging in and submitting this. As a residential or small-business NEM customer, you still receive a monthly bill to track your “net energy charges.” These are any charges you owe for the energy you consume from SCE after we subtract any credit for surplus energy your system generates. » [MORE: Compare solar loan options](#) How will origination fees be paid?

How are origination fees calculated?

Monthly payment is the amount you'll pay. If you're paying \$205 per month today, that's about \$87,000 you'll spend on electricity in the next 25 years, accounting for inflation. Solar panel systems typically last for 25 years or more and offset most or all of your monthly electric bill, which means you can avoid the vast majority of that. 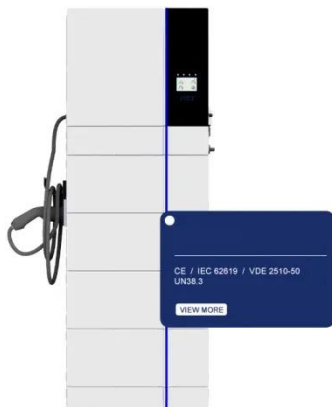
