Cabinet approval has been granted to award tenders for the installation of a 160 MW / 640 MWh Battery Energy Storage System (BESS), aimed at enabling the maximum integration of solar power into Sri Lanka's national electricity grid. The Energy Ministry says 153 bids were submitted for the 16 grid.
