Overview

Residential solar energy installations are typically covered as part of a standard homeowners policy, according to the U. Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL). Coverage varies dramatically by installation type: Roof-mounted panels are typically covered under dwelling coverage with higher limits, while ground-mounted systems fall under “other structures” coverage limited to just 10% of your dwelling coverage—potentially leaving expensive systems. The Residential Clean Energy Credit equals 30% of the costs of new, qualified clean energy property for your home installed anytime from 2022 through Decem. The credit is not available for any property placed in service after Decem. You may be able to take the credit if you. Homeowners insurance may cover solar panels under your policy's dwelling coverage if your panels are permanently attached to the roof and damaged due to certain covered perils, often excluding wind and hail. Homeowners insurance typically offers protection against certain risks — often called perils — such as theft. Before taxes, an installed rooftop solar energy system can cost anywhere between \$15,000 and \$25,000, according to the Center for Sustainable Energy. Paying to replace a damaged system could be a big financial burden for some homeowners. But there's a lot to consider before you plug into the sun. 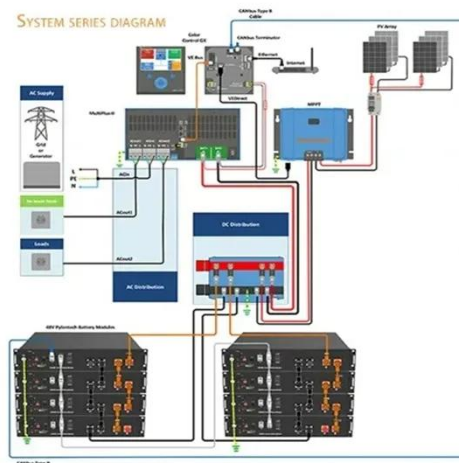
